


This instrument witnesseth That the Board of Regents for and on behalf of the Education Department of the State of New York has granted this absolute charter


1. Incorporating Natalie W. Owen, Dorothy M. Pixley, David B. Johnson, Susanna R. Chapin and Hollie R. Alperson and their associates and successors in office at a free public library, in accordance with the vote establishing the same, under the corporate name of Richmond Memorial Library, to be located in Batavia, Seneca County.

2. The library shall be administered by a board of five trustees, to be at first the persons who are named herein as incorporators, whose terms of office were fixed by lot so that such terms of said trustees, in the order in which they are named hereinabove, shall expire on June 30th, in the years 1960, 1961, 1962, 1963, and 1964. Thereafter, as such terms expire, their successors shall be elected by the qualified voters of City School District of the City of Batavia for a full term of five years. Vacancies due to cause other than expiration of term shall be filled for the balance of the unexpired term by the board of trustees.
