This morning we met Mr Dennis. Mr. Ed. Hodgman and I went to "Povles" - then Ed and I went to Barnsley - Received my new letter of credit. This afternoon we went to the Tower Hotel to stay this evening.

3rd.

This morning Ed. Hodgman and I went to the "British Museum" and

this afternoon Ed and I went to the same "Tussauds Wax Works". This evening went to Moores & Benedict's minstrels.

4th.

This morning Ed went to Churcl. I rode to Stile Otis and McBride. Hodgman and I went up to the Langham - Mr. Paige called this evening. Has invited to dinner with Mr. O'Brien. Ed went mother.

5th.

Today Ed. Hodgman. Mr. O'Brien and I made an excursion to Crystal Palace. O'Brien dined with us. This evening all went to the "Argyl rooms" met Mr. Paige there.

6th.

Mr. Paige breakfasted with me.

He intended to have gone to Hindscarth Castle but got left.

Hodgeman and I went to "Hot man ster Abbey" "House of Parliament" and to the Queen's Stables, got in by a "bag". This evening received a long letter from Mary, and one from Holly Bradish - Wrote to Mary.

7th

It was very pleasant here today. He did not get up till near noon. Hodgeman and I went to Broad Challop - Received Totnes letter. This evening Hodgeman and I went to the Burnside Gardens - found a letter from Mrs Martindale here on my return -

8th

We all went to Hindscarth Castle today -

9th

It was very unpleasant here today. This morning wrote many a long letter. This afternoon packed our trunks, and went down to Boller.

10th

Sent many a description of Hindscarth Castle. We left for Oxford by the morning train, and arrived there in about two hours. We put up at Clarendon Hotel. Then went to "Radcliffe Library" "Bodleian Library" one of the most valuable collections of books and "ms" in Europe - "Keble Hall" Chapel - "new museum".

Wrote to Mother & his Martindale. Also visited the martyrs' memorial where Archbishop Cranmer and Bishops Ridley and Latimer were burned in 1535 -

11th

This morning wrote to Mary, started for church this afternoon, but got left.

12th

We went to Magdalene College this morning, and at 11.45 left for Stratford-on-Avon - arrived there about 12.30 - visited Shakespeare's House - his Museum - saw the house where he was born - also visited the Church - at 1.45 left for Warwick and arrived there at 6.45 - stopped at Warwick and Old Red House at Stratford

13th

He had breakfast pretty early and then to the "Bastle" the Royal Family being away we were shown through. He left for Konstanz at

11.05 and arrived there at 11.15 - and visited the ruins of the Ancient Castle, and about 3.30 left for Rugby and arrived there in about an hour - Wrote to Minnie - also to Mary

14th

This morning we went to the Schloss and then went around the city, and at four left for Sheffield - road put up at the Royal Victoria - went to the Theatre this evening.

15th

This morning went through Rogers Manufactory - bought Mary and myself a dressing case. We left for York at 1.30 arrived there at 3 - went to the Cathedral, and at 4.45 left for Newcastle - we arrived

there at 7.45 stopped at "Yurk's Head"

16th

This morning called at the Pybus
He took me through the Castle etc - at
4.30 left for Edinburgh and arrived
here at 7.30 came by the "flying Scots"
man. Received a long letter from
Mary and one from Gurney.
Wrote to Mary.

17th 18th

We visited - The Castle - Parliament
House - St Giles Church - Holyrood Palace.
Canongate - National Gallery - Antiqui-
ty Museum and Statue Gallery - Pic-
ture Gallery - Assembly Hall - Burns
Museum and Burns Library - Advocates
Library - Canongate Tollbooth - White
Horse Inn (Dr Johnson's "Arthus Seat")
Scott's - Burns - Pitts - Melville houses etc

19th

This evening went a shopping -
We went to Leith and purchased

20th

Mailed many a letter of 22 pages
He left for Stirling at 12-25 and ar-
rived there at about two - went to
the Royal - we then visited the Castle -

21st

We left for Glasgow at 8.30 arrived
there about ten - stopped at McLean's
We went around the City - this evening
went to see Lydia Thompson.

22-

Left for Oban at 7 this morning
and arrived there at five - steamers
Glen - Canal - Chevalier stopped at
Great Western - met Mr & Mrs Shillaker of
California - Wrote to Revd

23-

It rained all day

24th

Mr Skellaber- Ed and I left for Iona at eight- thence around Isle of Mull- hence to Fingals Cave- got back about seven.

25th

Ed went to church this morning I wrote to Mary - Ed wrote mother. This evening I went- visiting with some married ladies and gentlemen - went to Dundaff Castle

26-

We left for Glasgow at eight, arrived there a little after seven- went to our hotel packed our things and took the cars for Greenock- thence by boat to Belfast-

27-

Arrived at Belfast about five- left our things at the Imperial Hotel and at 6.45 left for Giants Causeway- (Portrush) arrived there at 9- a party of us took a boat and went through the caves- left at 3.30 for Belfast- Received a long letter from Mary & one from mother

28-

This morning we went around the city and at 1.45 left for Dublin and arrived here at 6.45- put up at the Shelburne- went to the ^{grafted} Gaiety Theatre this evening.

29th

This morning we took a carriage drove to the Castle- Trinity College- Four Courts- Trinity Church- St Patricks Cathedral- Bank of Ireland- Nelsons monument- Wellingtons Ste-

lists - Royal Exchange etc - Wrote man
a letter of 16 pages this evening
we went to the Gaiety Theatre - play
was "First Lessons in Love" damed for

30th

We left for Limerick this morning
and arrived there this afternoon -
visited Cathedral - Castle & Treaty Stone -
Cruis Hotel

July

1st

Left at 10:30 for Killarney - arrived at
12:30 - visited the Castle - got some lunch
and at 4 left for Killarney and ar-
rived there at 6 - stopped at Royal
Victoria on the Lakes

2nd

Got acquainted with a Mr. Thomas
Thorntan - this afternoon we went to
Muckross Abbey - and Fox Cascade

3rd

Today we went to the Gap of Dunloe
Left at 10 - took a car to the Gap where
we took boats to the Lakes had our
lunch - and then started back by boat
(3 Lakes - Upper - Middle or Fox - Lower a Leane
Eagles nest - Lamb & Elephant Island etc - we
got back between four and five.
